2 Kings 10:15.



Annual Conference is in Colorado Springs this year. We will hear from our keynoter, Rev. Janet Wolf who is an elder in The United Methodist Church. She has written several books in including The Gospel of of March and Radical Discipleship. She is also very involved with the Children's Defense Fund working on child advocacy to dismantle the cradle-to-prison pipeline. We will also hear from Bishop Cedrick Bridgeforth of the Greater Northwest Episcopal Area which is the area encompassing Alaska, Oregon, Idaho, and Washington. He will speak on Intersecting Identities Are Tools of Liberation." Bishop Bridgeforth is the first openly gay African American episcopal leader in United Methodism. And the third speaker is Piper Ramsey-Smner who works with youth ministry, homeless outreach, and intentional communal living.

This is the 7th year of what is a routine 4 year stretch between General Conferences. Due to Covid 19, the General Conference was postponed until 2024. We will be voting on some General Conference petitions. Each day on the Mountain Sky webpage there should be an update of voting and discussions. MISSION TEAMS

Wednesday is their "off day" and they plan on going to the Aquarium. Thursday is helping Community Ministry with handing out pet supplies, and Friday they will be at Mercy Housing, Holly Park to help assemble bikes. I will also be teaching about food insecurity. On Friday afternoon we will close with communion.

The second team is coming from Arkansas. They start their week at Food Bank of the Rockies. Tuesday they will help with Extreme Community makeover. Wednesday is their day off. Thursday we will go to Evergreen at 3 Sisters Park where I will lead the group on a hike and teach about environmental theology. Friday we will go to Mercy Housing to plant flowers and tidy the yard. We will close with communion on Friday afternoon, June 30. They will leave on Saturday, July 1 and the new pastor will wish them well as they are on their way.

I am so excited to have these two teams share their mission experience with us. This is a perfect ministry for me to end my appointment with Sacred Stones Ministries, Inc and Bethany UMC.
