

MY "CHURCH" MOMENT

Mercy and Justice are not always found in great, dramatic ways. The poor don't just turn into the rich when the right laws are changed, or when they get enough food from the rich or when medical care is provided to all. The power of the spirit that people feel when they are able to ask for help, and are willing to do what needs to be done to improve their families lives can be seen in small, tender ways.

One of the times I took a group to Matamoros, Mexico a team of us was assigned to build a cinder block house for a family of four. The family had struggled, but finally saved the \$200 required to purchase the small plot of land. In the meantime, they had built a temporary shack out of bits and pieces of corrugated plastic sheeting and old boards. Of course, most of us couldn't speak any Spanish, nor did they speak English. But, smiling and nodding seemed to be enough.

The family knew that I was the minister, and smiled at me when I was introduced. A woman minister is problematic because of the strong Catholic worldview. So, we had worked for several days and the woman and her small child would peer shyly around the corners of their home as they watched us work.

On the fourth day, we were taking a water break. The woman, carrying her new baby, followed by the little girl, tentatively came out of her shack and headed towards me. She motioned for me to sit on the unfinished wall of her new house. So, I did. Then she gently handed me her sleeping baby. She offered me the gift of sharing her baby. I was so touched. I cooed and kissed the baby, and then blessed her. Several minutes later when I handed the baby back, the mother smiled at me which said thank you.

The rest of the team just watched in silence. It was a holy moment of crossing all the boundaries that the world had set up between us and them. The moment of new life which will bring the promises of grace and the heart aches of living in poverty. That moment changed my life. That moment was church to me and will always be a defining moment of church, the body of Christ.
